Mission Cooperative Appeal: Weekend of July 6th & 7th: Fr. Emmanuel Katabaazi will address the congregation. He is an ordained Diocesan priest serving in the Diocese of Masaka, UGANDA, East Africa. Under the guidance of Fr. Katabaazi and sponsorship of ROTA (Reaching Out 2 Africa), a new medical store building was built and dedicated in the Diocese of Masaka in 2012.
