RE-IGNITING OUR FAITH!

Bishop Edward Scharfenberger presided at Mass this past Saturday, December 15th, and addressed concerns of the parishioners following Mass. Many issues were brought forward, and Bishop Ed graciously answered these concerns and issues, with much clarification and satisfaction. Bishop Ed explained that the 30% of the money which is slated for the Diocese will be placed in a 5013C account and its distribution will be governed by a Lay Board. The funds will be dispersed through grants, and can only be used for the issues explained by Bishop Ed. One issue of importance is that many of our older, retired priests never received Social Security or pensions and a part of this 30% will be used to care for and assist this group. A part of the percentage going to the Diocese is also slated for distribution in assisting our Catholic Schools, evangelization, and educating our Seminarians. Funds cannot and will not be dispersed for any other reason! With this clarification and after months of planning, hope and prayer, we can go forward to reach our goal. With your support, we can be assured of a successful campaign! Remember, this is our legacy for those to come! Still, if many of you are struggling and discerning your contribution, please contact me. Remember, we cannot shepherd each other if we let our anger get the best of us.
