

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast & abstinence. "Abstinence" is to abstain from meat.

"Fasting" means not eating in-between meals and only having one main meal with two smaller meals not equaling the main meal.

Also, the custom n our Diocese is to observe Lenten Fridays as days of abstinence. Those ages 18 to 59 are asked to fast and abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
