

### "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE"

The Gospel of John contains seven "I am" statements by Jesus that make known his identity and also connect him to God, the Father who revealed himself to Moses by stating, "I am who I am. In today's Gospel we find the first of these statements when Jesus tells the gathered crowd, "I am the bread of life; / whoever comes to me will never hunger, / and whoever believes in me will never thirst." The sustenance that Jesus will provide goes beyond the physical needs of the body to something even more essential. The bread which gives "life to the world" will animate heart and soul with charity and love, binding all in the one Body of Christ.
