## Cluster News

Capital Campaign: "Re-Igniting our Faith" - As outlined in our recent letter to all parishioners, we wish to reiterate the needs of our Cluster in conjunction with this Campaign:

### St. Isaac Jogues, Chestertown

- Repair/replace the front steps and walkway in front of church.
- Upgrade the sound system to modern technology while having the ability to easily replace worn parts.
- Repair the rectory garage.
- Add a shower to the half bath in the rectory.
- Install a bathroom in the church.
- Repair the stained-glass windows (by a specialized contractor) in the church.
- Create programs that suit the needs of the parish.

## St. Isaac Jogues, Hague

- Repair the leaks in the roof.
- Paint the interior walls.
- Paint the exterior of the stained-glass windows.
- Add benches on the side of the church to encourage conversation and for reflection.
- Spruce up the exterior with additional plants and bushes.

## St. James, North Creek

- Replace two boilers.
- Remove existing wood siding and replace with vinyl siding.
- Spot potential weaknesses in the slate roof to avoid leaks and clean slate.
- Replace the front doors of the church with wooden or glass doors.
- Install insulation in areas of the rectory.
- Add a protective wall or other solution to the parking lot in back.
- Extract some trees behind the church.
- Repair the roof over the sacristy.

## Pastoral Needs of the Diocese

- Providing adequate income and housing to retired priests who have served parishes well beyond their retirement years. The Bishop's Appeal does not address this need, nor does it currently fund this group of priests.
- Support for vocations; additional funds are required for seminarian formation and education because we have more seminarians than we ever had.
- Investing in our future and developing Catholic educational programs.
- Updating and developing new youth and young adult ministries.
- Evangelization and communication, including workshops, innovative marketing, access to written and electronic communication resources. Additionally, programs that support baptisms, family needs, grief counseling.
